Services Available*

The goal of All Broward Home Health Services is to provide cost effective care that enables the patient to remain in a familiar environment and function at the highest level possible.

Skilled Nursing

Full medical services of traditional home health for wound care, hi-tech infusion, diabetic teaching and management, Foley catheter care, respiratory and cardiac teaching and skilled observation, assessment and teaching of many diseases and nursing procedures.

Psychiatric Nursing

Specially trained Registered Nurses provide treatment, care and monitoring of patients with psychiatric and emotional disorders.

Home Health Aides

Certified Nursing Assistants/Home Health Aides assist patients with activities of daily living and personal care.

Physical Therapy

Licensed therapists use therapeutic methods to promote rehabilitation. Treatment modalities may include transfer and gait training, balance activities, muscle strengthening and re-education, massage, ice/heat application, ultrasound and teaching home exercise regimens.

Speech Therapy

Therapists knowledgeable in speech, hearing and language functions plan and implement programs to manage communication and swallowing disorders.

Occupational Therapy

Therapists help improve upper extremity strength and dexterity. This allows one to interact safely at home and in the community. Occupational Therapy tends to focus on activities of daily living skills such as dressing, bathing, meal preparation, fine motor control and problem solving abilities.

Medical Social Services

Licensed clinical social workers assist patients in solving problems that may arise through illness, including social, financial and transportation problems.

*Special Considerations

- Services furnished under Medicare have specific criteria which must be met in order for services to be covered.
- Medicare requires that the patient be homebound. A homebound patient is one who is confined to the home. Generally speaking, a patient will be considered homebound if he/she has a condition due to an illness or injury that restricts his/her ability to leave his/her place of residence. Absences from the home must be infrequent and of a short duration.
- Medicare services may only be rendered with the specific orders (prescription) of a physician. This would also require a qualifying diagnosis. Services provided are consistent with a plan of care established by the patient's physician.
- Medicare only allows for home health aide services when a qualifying service is being rendered. This would include Skilled nursing, Psychiatric nursing, or Speech and/or Physical therapy.
- Patients who reside in an assisted living facility are eligible for services, so long as the services being paid for are NOT being rendered by the assisted living facility.
- Patients who reside in a skilled nursing facility are not eligible for home health services under Medicare.
- Some services available are provided under arrangement or directly through third parties. Those services may be billed to you and/or your insurance separately from the services provided by All Broward Home Health Services.
- The availability of some services may be limited.
- Please call for any additional information.
- Costs: Home health services under Medicare are covered at no cost to the patient. **
